Symptom

In transaction OAC2 for a specific Document Type, value "*" (wildcard) was set to Document Class.

This configuration is necessary to allow attachment of different Documents in ArchiveLink.

Environment

SAP NetWeaver Release-independent

Reproducing the Issue

After customization on **OAC2**, adding * to Document Class to a Document Type, upload does not carry file extension.

Displaying the same file does not bring correct MIME from Document Class, causing a display issue.

Cause

Transaction OAC2 allow customization, therefore customized Document Types are customer's responsibility.

In transaction OAG1 option "Always Copy Document Class from Document Type" is enabled. This setting stores wildcard (*) as Document Class, instead of correct document MIME.

Resolution

After customization on OAC2, it is necessary to perform additional configuration to correctly save Document Class.

To save MIME from Document Class, **disable** "Always Copy Document Class from Document Type" in OAG1:

- 1. Go to transaction **OAG1**;
- 2. **Uncheck** the checkbox "**Always Copy Document Class from Document Type**" within the Storage Settings section:
- 3. Upload the file again and test the behavior.
